Measles

If you are unsure whether your children have been immunised you can ring your GP and get them to check, they are more than happy to provide a certificate of confirmation.

To ensure our register is up to date please fax your child's immunisation data through to the school office on 520 3259. Thank you to those parents who already have.

This is a good time to check for yourselves that your children's immunisation is up to date.

The Ministry of Health continues to inform local Auckland schools that there is a high risk of Measles.

If there is an outbreak at Newmarket Primary School then all children who are **not** immunised will be sent home immediately. They will be required to stay at home for a minimum of 2 weeks. The health and safety of all the children is paramount.

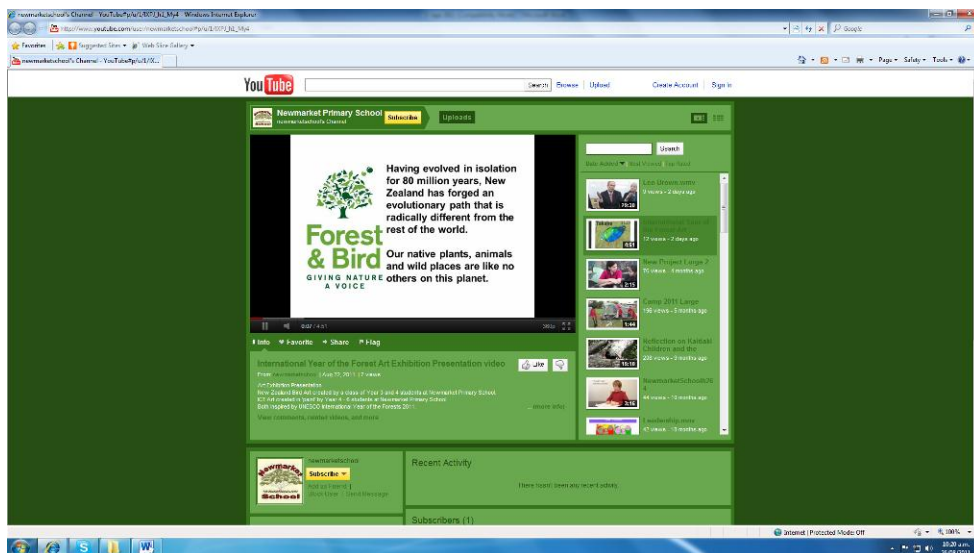
